IJAS author guidelines

- 1. ORCID ID and email should be as hyperlink
- 2. Keywords should be alphabetically arranged.
- 3. Arabic and English keywords must be matched in sequence.
- 4. Keywords should be from 4-6 words.
- 5. The abstract should be up to 250 words.
- 6. The English and Arabic abstract should be matched.
- 7. The tables should be editable table, and the figure should be clear and origin.
- 8. When you mention Figure in text, should be as (**Figure 1**), and the figure in the figure legend as **Figure 1**(without brackets).
- 9. When you mention Figure in text, should be as (**Table 1**), and the figure in the figure legend as **Table 1**(without brackets).
- 10. Self-citation do not exceed 4 %
- 11. 70% of the references should be updated; which has been published within the past five years..
- 12. Add the DOI number to all references, otherwise the URL of the article should be added.
- 13. The reference should be cited as APA style. Follow the instruction below:

- Same author, same year: (Garcia, 2020a, 2020b)
- **Different authors:** List by year, alphabetical, separated by semicolons (Lee, 2021; Martinez, 2021; Park, 2022)
